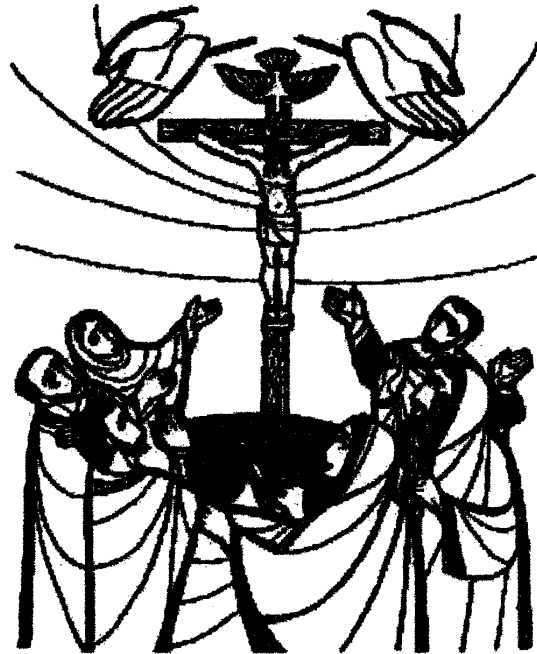

Book Club:

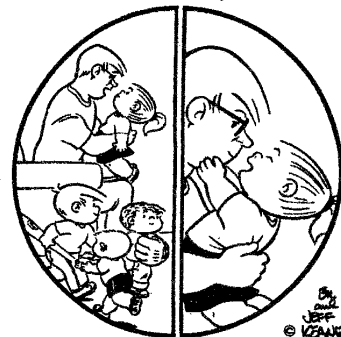
