# Good News!

October 30, 2022

*Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time (C)*

**Wis 11:22—12:2; 2 Thes 1:11—2:2; Lk 19:1—10**

When we hear this phrase from John 3:16, we think of God’s love for human beings—and rightly so. However, today’s first reading reminds us that God’s love is much broader. This reading offers us a glimpse into God’s love of all natural creation. The Greek word translated “world,” the word found in the passage from John as well as today’s reading, is *kósmos*, a word we think of today as “universe.” So we could say: “God so loved the cosmos.”

The author of the Book of Wisdom insists that God loves whatever God has made; that the power of the Creator is matched by the Creator’s love; and that this love is manifested through mercy to all. We are accustomed to hearing how God cares for us with holy abandon. This reading expands that love to include a tiny grain of sand or the morning dew. An even more daring statement claims that God’s imperishable spirit is in all things. How else could anything exist? This fact is the basis of what is referred to as “the intrinsic value of the entire natural world,” which means that everything has unique value simply because it was created by God—not because we can use it to enhance ourselves.

This kind of thinking might be new to many. However, it calls us to revere elements of nature like trees, flowers, wolves, and even mosquitos, because they are creatures of God. Our faith insists that “God so loved the cosmos.”

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# Buenas noticias

30 de octubre de 2022

*Trigésimo primer domingo del tiempo ordinario (C)*

**Sab 11:22—12:22; Tes 1:11—2:2; Lc 19:1—10**

Cuando escuchamos esta frase de Juan 3:16, pensamos en el amor de Dios por los seres humanos, y con razón. Sin embargo, la primera lectura de hoy nos recuerda que el amor de Dios es mucho más amplio. Esta lectura nos ofrece una visión del amor de Dios por toda la creación natural. La palabra griega traducida como “mundo”, que se encuentra tanto en el pasaje de Juan como en la lectura de hoy, es *kósmos*, una palabra que hoy conocemos como “universo”. Así que podríamos decir: “Dios amó tanto al cosmos”.

El autor del Libro de la Sabiduría insiste en que Dios ama todo lo que ha hecho; que el poder del Creador se corresponde con el amor del Creador; y que este amor se manifiesta a través de la misericordia hacia todos. Estamos acostumbrados a escuchar cómo Dios nos cuida con santo abandono. Esta lectura amplía ese amor para incluir un pequeño grano de arena o el rocío de la mañana. Una afirmación aún más atrevida afirma que el espíritu imperecedero de Dios está en todas las cosas. ¿Cómo podría existir algo si no? Este hecho es la base de lo que se denomina “el valor intrínseco de todo el mundo natural”, lo que significa que todo tiene un valor único simplemente porque fue creado por Dios, no porque podamos utilizarlo para mejorarnos.

Este tipo de pensamiento puede ser nuevo para muchos. Sin embargo, nos llama a venerar elementos de la naturaleza como los árboles, las flores, los lobos e incluso los mosquitos, porque son criaturas de Dios. Nuestra fe insiste en que “Dios amó tanto al cosmos”. *Hna. Dianne Bergant, CSA*

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# Dear Padre

October 30, 2022

***My aunt has terminal cancer. Her doctors have advised her to stop chemotherapy and begin palliative care, but she says that's equivalent to assisted suicide. Is that what the Church thinks?***

Palliative care doesn't prolong life, but neither does it cause life to end. The bishops are quite clear that palliative care is neither euthanasia nor assisted suicide, both of which are always sinful.

The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* says treating or not treating a patient in a way that will cause death is always murder (CCC 2277). However, a patient's choice to discontinue "burdensome, dangerous, extraordinary" treatment "can be legitimate" when it's done not to cause death, but in recognition of "one's inability to impede it" (CCC 2278). But even when death seems to be close, "ordinary care" that would be given to any sick person cannot be interrupted (CCC 2279).

Palliative care does not cause death. It gives terminally ill people spiritual support and relief from their physical symptoms. An excellent resource on this topic, "Killing the Pain, Not the Patient: Palliative Care vs.

Assisted Suicide," is available at [usccb.org](http://usccb.org).

The *Catechism* says palliative care "should be encouraged" (CCC 2279). It helps the dying person and the family focus on the gift of life and the blessing each person is. The patient who legitimately chooses palliative care is not waiting to die but rather living those last moments to the fullest and as comfortably as possible.

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# Querido Padre

30 de octubre de 2022

***Mi tía tiene un cáncer terminal. Sus médicos le han aconsejado que deje la quimioterapia y comience los cuidados paliativos, pero ella dice que eso equivale a un suicidio asistido. ¿Es eso lo que piensa la Iglesia?*** Los cuidados paliativos no prolongan la vida, pero tampoco hacen que la vida termine. Los obispos tienen muy claro que los cuidados paliativos no son ni eutanasia ni suicidio asistido, ambos siempre pecaminosos.

El *Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica* dice que tratar o no tratar a un paciente de manera que le cause la muerte es siempre un asesinato (CIC 2277). Sin embargo, la elección de un paciente de interrumpir un tratamiento "gravoso, peligroso y extraordinario" "puede ser legítima" cuando se hace no para causar la muerte, sino en reconocimiento de "la propia incapacidad para impedirlo" (CIC 2278). Pero incluso cuando la muerte parece estar cerca, no se pueden interrumpir los "cuidados ordinarios" que se darían a cualquier enfermo (CIC 2279).

Los cuidados paliativos no provocan la muerte. Proporcionan a los enfermos terminales apoyo espiritual y alivio de sus síntomas físicos. El *Catecismo* dice que los cuidados paliativos "deben fomentarse" (CIC 2279). Ayudan al moribundo y a su familia a centrarse en el don de la vida y en la bendición que supone cada persona. El paciente que elige legítimamente los cuidados paliativos no está esperando a morir, sino que vive esos últimos momentos de la manera más plena y cómoda posible.
